Nano Exposure & Contextual Information Database (NECID)

1. Product name and description

The Nano and Contextual Information Database (NECID) software, hereinafter referred to as NECID, helps users to capture extensive, harmonised data while measuring nanomaterial exposure. The aim is to create a structured, multi-purpose database. Application areas for NECID include exposure assessment and exposure modelling, risk analysis, epidemiological studies, describing the current state of technology and in some cases going on to determine limit values or assessment criteria. Beginning with documentation of the measurement strategy, followed by extensive capture of the ambient conditions and storage of the raw data supplied by measuring devices, a database is created, the benefit of which is its extreme versatility. For instance, in addition to the specific purpose for which measurements are originally made, the relevant data can subsequently be used to deliver meaningful results for future studies. The general aim is to achieve comparability of all measurements and documentations.

2. Multiple users

2.1 NECID may be used simultaneously by the authorised users named in section 3 of this certificate.

2.2 NECID may be installed and operated on several systems by the authorised users named in section 3 below. However, each authorised person may only use NECID on one computer, one device or one workstation at a time. The licensee must ensure that the personal access details of each user are only used by that particular authorised person.
